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Topic: Measuring international progress in pregnancy planning and preconception health

Brief Description: Interventions and policies to optimise preconception health are expanding globally. Evaluating their effectiveness requires robust population-level surveillance systems to monitor progress and inform future, targeted investment. However, there is currently no internationally agreed set of preconception health indicators suitable for global surveillance. This webinar will present an overview of the work of the International Core Indicators for Preconception Health and Equity (iCIPHE) Alliance, which seeks to address this gap. The talk will describe the development of an international consensus study to prioritise a core set of indicators applicable across low-, middle-, and high-income countries for monitoring progress in pregnancy planning and preconception health. Initial findings from the study will be shared, alongside opportunities for international collaboration.
